# About Us

The Village has over 30 historic buildings including a covered “kissing” bridge, log buildings, a Victorian bandstand, a railway station, Locomotive 103 and a general store.



These buildings are relocated from various sites around southern Ontario, creating a charming village with a nostalgic atmosphere. Westfield is surrounded by an additional 131 hectares of unspoiled natural woodlands and meadows with several nature trails.

Ceremonies may be held in one of two 19th century churches or outside at the Victorian bandstand. For the reception, there is the renovated Ironwood Hall.

# How to find us

From Hamilton - Follow Hwy. 8 northwest through Dundas, cross Hwy. 5 and continue to Kirkwall Road (formally Regional Road 552). Turn right on Kirkwall Road and proceed 1.5 km.

From Toronto - Take QEW West to Hwy. 403. Turn north onto Hwy. 6 to Hwy. 5. Turn left onto Hwy. 5, then right onto Hwy. 8 to Kirkwall Road. Turn right onto Kirkwall Road and proceed 1.5 km.

From Cambridge - Follow Hwy. 8 to Kirkwall Road. Turn left onto Kirkwall Road and proceed 1.5 km.





# Insurance Requirements

A comprehensive public liability and property insurance is required.

The policy taken out by the applicant should provide coverage for any single accident to a minimum limit of \$2,000,000 (two million) exclusive and cost against loss or damage to property arising in connection with the event.

All Certificates of Insurance must show Hamilton Region Conservation Authority as “additional insured” on the certificate. This certificate must be provided 30 days prior to the event taking place or the booking will be cancelled with no refund.

A Certificate of Liability may not be required if the renter is only using Westfield Heritage Village for the wedding ceremony.

Liquor may be served at Ironwood Hall under the authority of a Special Occasion Permit. A copy of the Special Occasion Permit must be submitted to the Hamilton Region Conservation Authority three weeks prior to the date of the event. The original permit must be posted in a prominent location at the facility on the day of the event.
