Pre-Civil War Opulence

Victoria Mansion was built between 1858 and 1860 as a summer home for Ruggles Sylvester Morse, a Maine native who made his fortune in New Orleans as the proprietor of luxury hotels. The Mansion's interiors are remarkably intact and are exceptional for their *trompe l'oeil* painted walls and ceilings, ornamental plasterwork, carved marble fireplaces, stained glass, and original furnishings. The quality and preservation of these lavish interiors make Victoria Mansion an unparalleled and widely admired example of pre-Civil War grandeur.
