About Knitting Factory


Knitting Factory was originally founded in 1987 on the Lower East Side. It subsequently moved to TriBeCa until crossing the East River in 2009 when Knitting Factory found its current home in the beautiful 5,000 square foot Williamsburg building on Metropolitan Ave.

The Neighborhood

The Knitting Factory is located in the heart of Williamsburg, Brooklyn. Home to art, culture, music and intrigue, Williamsburg has always been a hub for creativity. Knitting Factory is located just a couple blocks from the L, G, J and M trains, right of the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway and a short distance from McCarren Park.

Main Venue

Entering the double doors of Knitting Factory is the front room that features exposed brick and rustic, wooden textures. It can fit upwards of 80 people, comfortably fitting for a cocktail hour.

The high tables and chairs are easily removable to fit more standing guests. Enjoy music from our speaker system and relish in craft beers and well liquors at the fully stocked bar.

The main performance venue is a 300 capacity standing main venue and performance space. Stand on the 24x17 ft stage for your ceremony and enjoy fine drinks from the two fully stocked bars, listen to music from your favorite band or DJ through our state of the art sound system, and project a video or slideshow on our 13 ft. projection screen.

Deposits and Cancellation Policy

We require a 25% non-refundable deposit to secure the date for your event. The balance of payment is due 30 days prior to the event and is payable by cash, check, or credit card. Cancellation must be given in writing at least 90 days in advance, any less will result in extra fees.

Transportation

If you plan to drive, there is street parking around the building. Unfortunately we cannot reserve spots but will do our best to accommodate space for guests. You can also easily get to The Knitting Factory by public transportation via the J/M/Z trains at Marcy Ave, G at Metropolitan or the L at Lorimer.
