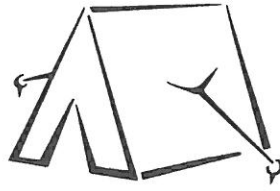

CAMPING AT THE FLORIDA FFA LEADERSHIP TRAINING CENTER

Imagine yourself on beautiful Catfish Creek, catching a large mouth bass and cooking it over your own campfire. This almost sounds too good to be true...but believe me the setting of our campground makes you feel totally removed from the hustle and bustle of your day to day life.

Campsites are available for large or small parties. Amenities include a bathhouse with male and female showers, hot water, electricity and a water fountain. Picnic tables and grills are available as well.

Camping will not be the same unless you canoe up Catfish Creek or out in Lake Pierce. Bird watching and seeing Florida wildlife and plants can be very educational. Canoes are rented through the front desk at the Lodge and come with paddles and vest.

Camping rates are \$30.00 per site, plus tax. Sites accommodate up to four (4) people in one larger tent or pup tents.

ROPES COURSE EVENTS/PROCESSES

HIGH ELEMENTS

Quantum Leap

Participant climbs 30 ft. pole to stand on 1ft .x 1ft. platform and jumps to ring bell 6 ft. away. Participant on dynamic belay (from ground) using climbing rope, full body helmet, locking carabineers, etc.

Pamper-Pole

Participant stands on 30 ft. pole and leaps thru a trapeze

Multi Vine

Standing on steel cable, participant crosses using vines to hold onto.

LOW ELEMENTS

TP Shuffle

2 Groups cross on a telephone pole helping each other

Island Muse

Crossing on 3 different size logs, using a certain sequence to get to each log

All Aboard

The entire group must balance on a log suspended 1 ft. off the ground for a count of 10, with no body parts touching the ground.

Swinging Log

An entire group must balance on a log suspended 1 ft. off the ground for a count of 10, With no body parts touching the ground.

Mohawk Walk

An entire group moves across an imaginary swamp by walking along tautly strung cables 18' off the ground, moving from tree to tree, assisting each other across each expanse.

Island Crossing

3 platforms, (1 small) logs from one platform to another. Put participants over 12' wall

Trust Platform

The Trust Platform is a 4-5' high platform from which an individual participant falls backward into the arms of the group. This activity is used at the end of a trust sequence that typically includes Standing Trust Falls, Triad Falls, and Willow-n-the-Wind.

Nitro Crossing

An entire group must cross an imaginary bottomless pit and land on a 3' x 3' platform without knocking down the bamboo poles on either side. In addition, the group must transport a cup of "nitro" (water) safely across without spilling.

Spider's Web

An entire group moves through a large web constructed of nylon without disturbing the web. As each web space is used, it is "closed" to further use by the group.



LEADERSHIP TRAINING CENTER ROPES COURSE

Our thirteen (13) element ropes course, with high and low elements (40 foot cat walk and 30 foot power pole), has been designed to provide you with the very best in team building experiences. Team building issues such as communication, creative problem solving, appropriate risk-taking strategies, stress reduction and many other professional developmental themes are addressed when using the course to further your organization's goals.

Start your day's program with mixers and warm-up activities designed to build enthusiasm before approaching the **"WILD WOOSEY"** which pairs participants to support each other physically while traversing on separate cables. Move on to the **"MOHAWK WALK"** where the object is to move along the cables to a point that they have set as an end goal. Cooperation and personal commitment are stressed in these elements as well as the **"TRUST FALL."**

Other elements are challenged throughout the program ending with the **"QUANTUM LEAP"** or possibly more aptly named the **"ULTIMATE LEAP."** Your leap from the 30 foot pole is truly the *ultimate*, in that you have developed trust and are willing to put that trust into action while your team mates guide you back to earth.

The best learning experience is where we learn by doing and that people working together can reach extraordinary levels of accomplishment. Opportunities are created for participants to move beyond self-imposed barriers and experience new capacities within themselves and others.
