Full Meal Deal: Ceremony, rehearsal as scheduled, one or two in-person meetings, all electronic communications, coordination with your planner and other vendors.

Just the Facts: All the features of the Full Meal Deal, except no rehearsal; all consultations are done electronically (phone, email, text or Zoom). A walk-through is included an hour or so before the ceremony.

Shotgun: Elopement scheduled no earlier than five days before the wedding, for fewer than ten guests. Weekdays only. Payment in full at booking.

Get 'r Done: "Last minute" quick elopements only in my Monroe shop, arranged day of or day before on an as-available basis. Payment in full at booking.

Holidays: All federal holidays, plus Valentine's Day, Palm Sunday, Good Friday, August 14, September 27, Thanksgiving weekend (Th-Su), Christmas Eve and New Years Eve.

Travel: The first 40 one-way road miles are free. Thereafter, the fee is \$4.00 per mile. Tolls, fares, parking are extra in all mileage scenarios.

Preferred venues: There is a \$25 discount for Full Meal Deal and Holiday packages at our preferred venues, Please ask if yours is included.

Public defender: Active duty military, commissioned law enforcement and fire/EMS personnel receive a \$25 discount off any package.

Deposits and payment at booking: A deposit of \$200 and a signed contract is required to hold your wedding on my calendar, first come first served.. Full payment of any non-elopement package at time of booking receives a \$25 discount.

SYMBIS Assessment, an acronym for Saving Your Marriage Before It Starts. Chaplain Dale is a certified SYMBIS facilitator for pre-marriage counseling

Note: To provide every couple with excellent service, I book only one wedding per weekend (F-Su); and one wedding per four-day string of weekdays (M-Th).
