Event Venues

The Ballroom— Second Floor

This room has views of the Detroit River and Detroit Yacht Club Harbor. There is a beautiful veranda that wraps around the entire length of the room with doors allowing for direct access to the outdoors. Most brides and grooms choose to entertain their guests on the veranda for cocktail hour. Although the room does not have air conditioning, it was designed to generate a cross breeze from the river. The Ballroom has elegant hardwood floors and a cathedral ceiling that is three stories high with hand painted details dating back to the early 1920's. This room can accommodate both a ceremony and reception, depending on the size of the group.

Capacity: 150– 420 people depending on set up

Facility Rental: \$550

The Fountain Room— Second Floor

The Fountain Room is a large, beautiful room with a bar area, the River Vista, overlooking the Detroit Yacht Club Harbor and Detroit River. The fountain that the room was named after was removed in 1952 to make more space for diners when the room was only open for Club dining. The back of the fountain was discovered during renovations and restored in 1993. This room can accommodate both a ceremony and reception, depending on the size of the group.

Capacity: Up to 180 guests

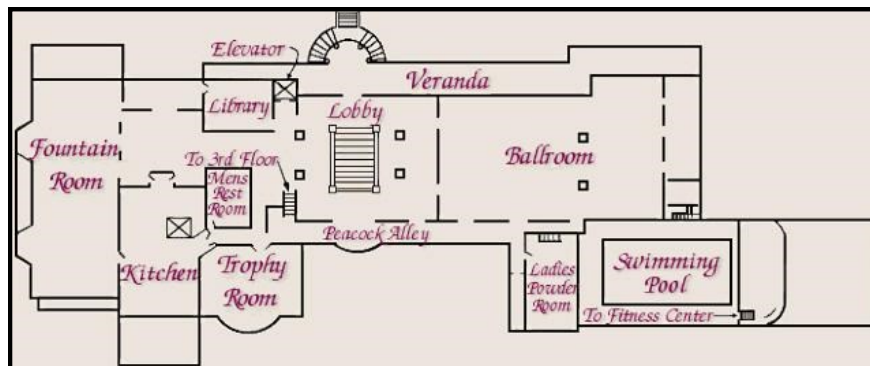

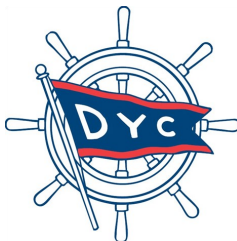
The Trophy Room— Second Floor

There are many well known trophies in this room. The best known is the Robert Oakman Trophy commissioned from Louis Comfort Tiffany in 1919, among many others. This room is great for an intimate dinner setting during a wedding or rehearsal, or for a daytime event such as a shower.

Capacity: Up to 75 guests

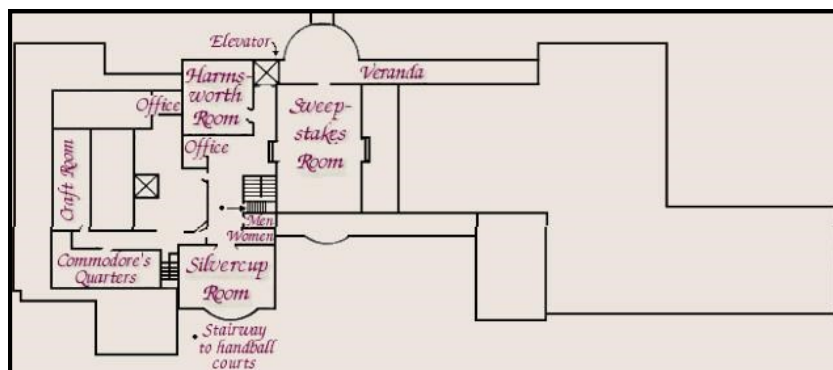

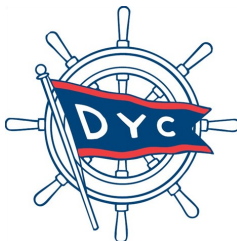
Starlight Circle– Outside

General Information

The Detroit Yacht Club is a private club operated for the pleasure and enjoyment of its members and their guests. As such, the Club provides facilities, food, beverage, and service for private events for DYC members and guests sponsored by a DYC member in good standing. The Club is proud of its magnificent facilities, fine food and staff of professionals who will do their utmost to please your guests in every possible way.

All reservations and agreements are subject to the Policies and Procedures of the Detroit Yacht Club.

The deposit for all weddings is \$1,000.00

All deposits/payments will be applied against charges for the event. In case of cancellation of the event by the host all deposits/payments received by the Detroit Yacht Club will be non refundable and considered the cancellation fee. All payments/deposits must be made by cashiers check or money order.

The payment fees for all events will follow this schedule and must be paid by a Money Order or Cashier's Check:

- * one year prior to the event
- * six months prior to the event
- * three months prior to the event
- * final payment due in full three business days prior to the event

The DYC maintains a Dress Code Policy in the Lobby and on the Second and Third floors of the Clubhouse.

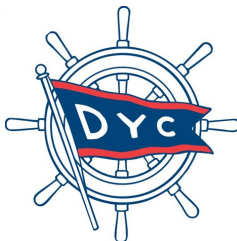
The person/organization hosting this event is responsible for notifying attendees of this policy.

Management reserves the right to inspect and control all events held on the premises. Throwing rice, birdseed, and flower petals inside function rooms and in public areas is prohibited. Attaching anything to walls, handrails, furniture, or artwork is strictly prohibited.

The DYC requires an alphabetized list of non-member attendees to any event 72 hours prior to the event.

The Club's House Rules prohibit any fundraisers other than those specifically approved in writing by The Board of Directors prior to the signing of this agreement.

Ticket selling at the entrance to any event held at the DYC will not be allowed.



General Information

Media advertising and the use of the Club's name and/or logo in any promotions will not be tolerated.

The DYC prohibits any "subcontracting" of Club space by any sponsor or host to party planners or any other person.

Club Policy may require security officers for groups whose size, program, or nature indicates such need. The determination will be at the sole discretion of the Club. The cost of this security will be the responsibility of the host of the event.

The DYC shall not assume responsibility for the damage or loss of any merchandise or articles left in the Club or meeting areas prior to or following events.

All food and beverage served at the Club must be provided by the Club.

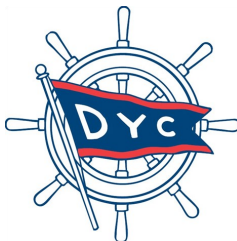
All arrangements for events including menus must be agreed upon by the Club and the host at least three weeks prior to the event.

Minimum guarantee number of guests for events with food are due three (3) business days prior to the event. This guarantee number or, the actual number of guests served (which ever is greater) is the number that will be used to prepare the charges for the event. If no guarantee is received, the Club reserves the right to use the number indicated on this signed agreement.

All dinners must be served by 9:00P, all beverage service and entertainment must end by 1:00A, and all rooms must be vacated by 1:30A.

All Federal, State, and Local laws with regard to food and beverage purchases and service are strictly adhered to. Michigan law prohibits the service of alcoholic beverages to persons who cannot prove that they are at least 21 years of age, or to persons who may be intoxicated. Management reserves the right to make this determination.

Taxes will be applied to all applicable products and services unless the hosting organization provides proof of their tax exemption prior to the event. Groups requesting tax exemption must submit their tax number and a letter requesting exemption at least two weeks prior to the event.

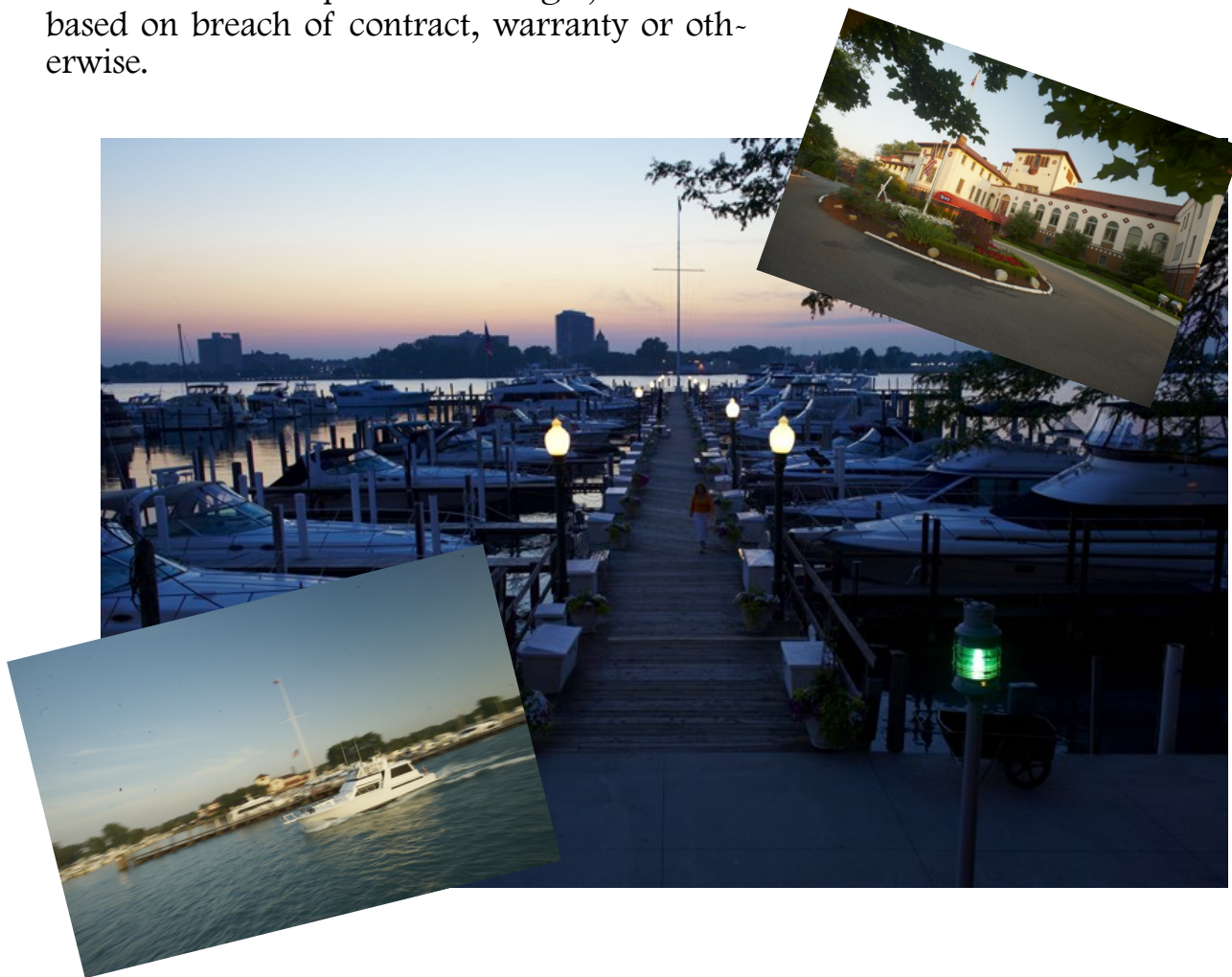


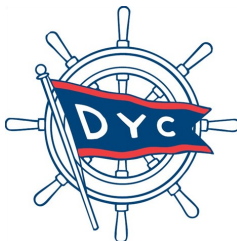
General Information Continued

Pricing for food, beverages, and other services is updated regularly. The prices guaranteed for this event will be the ones current at the time the contract is received along with the non refundable deposit. Confirmation of the pricing will be listed on the Banquet Event Order for the event when details are finalized for that event. The DYC requires a minimum of twenty-five dollars per person spent towards food on a Friday or Saturday evening.

Unconsumed food will remain property of the club. Members and guests are not permitted to carry out leftover food, nor with the club staff be allowed to box or package any special event food to leave the dining room for a guest. Similarly, leftover food prepared by the club will not be left at a catering site. (This rule excludes birthday cakes, anniversary cakes, or the top tier of a wedding cake).

In no event shall the DYC be liable for loss of profit or for similar or dissimilar collateral or consequential damages, whether based on breach of contract, warranty or otherwise.
