MOUNTAIN BIKE AND HIKING TRAILS

LEGEND BOARD: Located across from mailbox, near Osprey Nest (inside fence line) east side of road near main entrance (County Road # 18)

- ORANGE  RICE LAKE VIEW ADVANCED 4.2 MILES
From Legend Board, left turn at Beaver's Corner, up hill, veer right, up hill to Max's Lookout, back down again same hill, turn left at bottom of hill (Turtle Junction), go by 2 ponds (Joele's and Kendal's Ponds), right at fence line, continue by Kendal's Pond, follow path by Snake Pond, Butterfly Pond, Bog Pond to Frog City Pond, veer right to Deer Hollow, follow path onto Hole #8, Hole #9 back around Hole #8 back down path to gate, across paved road to Old Barn, follow sand path over creek to service road to secondary road, down Blue Gill Road to Trailer Park Road back to Golden Beach Resort
- BLUE  GOLDEN BEACH SCENIC TRAIL ADVANCED 8 MILES
Turn right at Golden Beach Resort sign; go for 1 mile to Lilac Valley Road. Turn left, go approx. 200 ft and turn left onto Savory Road. Follow this road and you will go up a gigantic hill. Follow until intersection. Turn left, continue down road swinging to right onto First Line Rd. At Brook Road turn left. Continue on this paved road. Turn left onto County Road # 18 (Rice Lake Road) and follow the paved road all the way back to Golden Beach Resort.
- PURPLE  DODGE'S HILL INTERMEDIATE 1.7 MILES
Turn left at Golden Beach Resort main entrance, go up Dodge's Hill. There is a green house on your right, turn right, enter field (do not go down private driveway), follow path to in front of barn, turn left, go down hill and continue straight along, left at Beaver's Corner, turn right at Bog Pond, straight ahead to Frog City Pond, turn right, go to Deer Hollow, follow path to gate (paved road), turn right, follow paved road back to Golden Beach Resort.
- PINK  OSPREY TRAIL EASY 0.6 MILES
From Legend Board, follow path to Beaver's Corner, turn left, take path to Turtle Junction. Turn right to Blue Jay Turn (between 2 ponds, Kendal's Pond & Joele's Pond), follow path back to Beaver's Corner, back by Osprey Nest to Legend Board.
- YELLOW  CEDAR TRAIL EASY 1.3 MILES
Just across from compost site and west down the road 50 ft, look for Yellow Arrow on tree. Follow cut trail to Jeremy's Corner, veer left. Follow path by Roger's Back Forty. Follow path, turn right onto Fox Den Trail, down path to Freckles Hollow, by Log Cabin Pass onto private gravel driveway, walk across grass to creek, over bridge, by Pheasant Run, by Eva's Trail, turn left at Jeremy's Corner, back down Cedar Trail to Golden Beach Resort.
- RED  LOUISE'S LOOP VERY EASY 0.5 MILES
At Legend Board, follow path to Beaver's Corner, turn right. Follow path to Deer Hollow. Continue on path to paved road back to Golden Beach Resort Legend Board.
- GREEN  BETTY BOOP LOOP SUPER EASY 0.4 MILES
From Legend Board go by Osprey Nest on hydro pole to Beaver's Corner. Turn right, follow path to Deer Hollow. Turn right, short walk to Amy's Turn. Turn right, follow path over creek back to the Legend Board
