Fire Engine Rental:

The Museum has a number of fire engines that can be rented. For weddings, these are typically used for transporting the bride and groom to or from the wedding site, to the reception or rehearsal dinner, or for going away. The apparatus may also be used to transport VIPs to an event and to take short rides in the parking area.



Guided Tours:

Visitors can take a self-guided audio tour of the museum and the Great Fire exhibit. Guided tours of the exhibits are available for an additional fee, which varies depending upon the number of guests and duration of the tours.

Arrangements for guided tours must be made at least 2 weeks in advance of the event date.

Candle-Lit Events:

Candles and kerosene lanterns throw a beautiful multi-colored light during evening events. Candles may be used if they are in protected glass, or for a small fee, the Museum will light the kerosene lanterns on the apparatus.

OUR FACILITY

P he Fire Museum of Maryland provides a unique setting for your event where guests can be entertained among steam pumping engines, giant hook-and-ladder trucks, and elaborate ceremonial parade vehicles used by early volunteer fire companies.

Established in 1971, the Museum is one of the largest and most comprehensive collections of antique fire fighting equipment in the world. More than forty shining examples of hand-pulled, horse-drawn and motorized fire apparatus from 1806 to 1957 are on display.

The Main Museum is available for stand-up receptions, sit-down dinners, and other gatherings. The Main Exhibit Hall is ideal for large events. The 16,000 square foot gallery can accommodate up to 190 guests for a seated meal or a reception for 250. If you are looking for a smaller meeting space, we have rooms that hold anywhere from 10-40 guests.

The Museum is conveniently located behind the eightstory Heaver Plaza Office Building, just one block north of Exit 26B of the Baltimore Beltway (I-695).

- Ample free parking is available for evening and weekend rentals.
- The Museum is a smoke-free environment.

AVAILABILITY

The Museum is available for day or evening events 7 days a week Sunday—Saturday. Rental of the Fire Museum of Maryland changes seasonally. Please call for availability at 410-321-7500 ext. 103.

CATERING

All catering, venue and arrangements (including but not limited to decorations, music and entertainment) are the responsibility of the renter.

The Museum will provide, upon request, a list of caterers who are familiar with the Museum and its facilities.

The caterer must provide the Museum with a Certificate of Insurance at least a week prior to the event. Caterer must also obtain appropriate liquor licenses and permits in advance of the event and submit them to the Museum's contact.

NOTES

- A signed contract, letter of agreement and deposit are required to reserve the museum.
- The Fire Museum of Maryland will make every reasonable effort to cooperate with the renter's needs, but reserves the right to approve event activities and to determine their suitability for the Museum and its facilities.

PAYMENT

- A deposit of one—half of the rental is to be paid when the facility is reserved.
- The remaining balance is due one week before the scheduled function.
- In the event of cancelation by the client, one—half of the rental fee deposit will be refunded, provided that the cancelation notice is given no less than two weeks prior to the reserved date.

RENTAL SPACES & PRICING

Basic Rental of Museum includes: Main Museum Exhibit Space, Discovery Room, On-Site Coordinator, Parking lot Adjacent to Museum and Catering Set-Up Area.

Main Exhibit Hall:

Parties, receptions gatherings of all kinds. The main hall is 100 X 160' or 16,000 sq. ft. The adjacent Discovery Room is available for transitional dining or dancing.
