#### **DISCOUNT ELIGIBILITY**

# **BOOKING & HOTEL POLICIES**

#### **BOOKING DEPOSIT:**

A \$1,000 non-refundable deposit is required to hold the venue space and block hotel rooms. This deposit can be made via cash, certified cheque or credit card.

#### **ROOM BLOCK:**

A block of guest rooms will be allocated for the group based on the signed contract. Your delegates will be required to call direct to book available rooms. A valid credit card is required to guarantee the reservation. Summerland Resort takes a deposit of the first night's stay, plus all applicable taxes for each guest room reservation. In the event of cancellation, this amount will be immediately refunded with a minimum of 3 days' notice; else the deposit is non-refundable.

#### **ROOM BLOCK RELEASE:**

The block of rooms indicated on the signed contract will remain until 60 days prior to the event date. At 60 days the room block will be released and rooms can be booked from regular availability and rates.

# **GROUP CANCELLATION:**

Cancellation notice of 45 days is required in writing to The Hotel. Should the group cancel within 45 days of the scheduled date, the deposit and 50% of all room, venue, rental, food & beverage charges will be processed and retained.

#### **INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION:**

Cancellation of any guest rooms for a group reservation is required in writing 72 hours in advance of arrival.

Reservations cancelled inside the stated policy dates days will result in the full charge of the stay including tax.

#### **PET FRIENDLY ROOMS:**

Advanced requests are available for pet friendly rooms. They are not guaranteed as only select rooms at the Summerland Waterfront Resort & Spa allow pets.

#### SUMMERLAND & AREA GROUP ACTIVITIES

#### **GOLFING:**

Some of the best golfing in the Okanagan is only minutes from the Summerland Waterfront Resort & Spa. The Summerland Golf & Country Club, a 15 minutes drive from the Resort, offers moderately challenging holes, many of which overlook the Trout Creek Canyon.



#### HIKING

Get some altitude in Summerland with awe-inspiring views of Okanagan Lake and Summerland. Hike the trails up to the summit at Giant's Head Mountain Park, an extinct volcano which is now a mountain with a face that resembles the profile of a man. This hike is about 5 minutes drive from the Resort.



#### **ORCHARD TOURS:**

Dickinson's Family Farm, since 1912, is well known in the Okanagan for its large orchards of peaches, apricots, cherries, pears, prunes, apples and plums. Private group tours are available but you also walk amongst the 10 acres in a self guided tour.



# **RAIL TOURS:**

The Kettle Valley Railway offers a unique two-hour steam powered train journey on one of BC's few remaining fully operational steam railways. From May to October, enjoy a tour along a preserved ten-kilometre section of the original railway. Fun for groups is the Great Train Robbery and BBQ. Experience the thrill of seeing the Garnett Valley Gange ride out of the hills to board the train and rob passengers for donations to local charities.



#### **TROUT HATCHERY:**

The Summerland Trout Hatchery, located beside the Resort, offers year round self guided tours. Learn more about freshwater fisheries and conservation activities.

#### **WINE TOURS:**

Summerland's Bottleneck Drive is the latest hot spot on the Okanagan wine scene. Your group will experience four award winning wineries as well as the spectacular vistas and rolling hills of the surrounding agricultural landscape. Wine tours of the Naramata Bench are also popular. Customized tours are available for groups with Okanagan Experiences Tours (formerly Top Cat Tours).
