Month-Of planning includes the following:

Pre-Wedding

- Unlimited Consultations

 - Point-of contact support for all wedding vendors for the two months prior to the wedding
 - Rehearsal Coordination: This includes organizing the rehearsal and booking the rehearsal location.
 - Rental and Floor Plan Coordination
 - Additional Vendor Research and Inspiration
- Partial Payment Management (for the 60 days prior to the wedding and the week following): I can help create a schedule of your final payments, in order to organize and alleviate stress.
 - Unlimited Meetings at the Venue with Vendors

Wedding Day

- Day Of Coordination: All of the day of logistics will be worked out beforehand so that you can have a stress free day. I will be present for vendor load in, the duration of the wedding, and clean up.
 - Distributing final payments and gratuities to vendors on the wedding day
 - Overseeing work by all wedding day vendors
 - Bridal Party Management
 - Supervising set-up of all decor items and event rental items
 - Coordinating with the DJ or Band with timing and the execution of special announcements

Post Wedding
