## THE PROPERTIES



#### **ORCHARD**

The Orchard is the heart and soul of the Seminary Hill Property.

Located on a hillside overlooking Callicoon, the Orchard offers stunning views of the Delaware River and a former seminary nestled at the bottom of the hill. The orchard offers a distinct landscape for your wedding, depending on the season. In spring, our 1200-tree orchard blooms delicate pink and white flowers. In summer, colorful fruits grow against deep green leaves. In autumn, apples and pears hang ripe for picking against the vibrant fall foliage.



#### **LONG FIELD**

The Long Field is a 65-acre property with unparalleled 360-degree views. The rolling pastoral acres, winding Delaware River, and towering Catskill mountains converge to form a breathtaking scene for photographs and vows. You'll find a stone fire pit for an optional bonfire, and a secret tire swing buried in the woods.



#### **HILLTOP HOUSE + GUEST CABIN**

The Hilltop House sits atop a ridge overlooking the Delaware River with stunning countryside in all directions. Built from timber felled on the property, the house is simply furnished, with kilim rugs covering the wood floors. Right outside are hiking & cross-country ski trails, and down the road is historic Main Street with restaurants, shops and more. The perfect escape from the hustle and bustle of the city, it's great for romantic getaways or large gatherings.


