

RAIN FOREST FOOD PAVILION

A vaulted ceiling, two rows of pillars, and two full walls of windows create an open and airy space filled with natural light. Host a cocktail hour on the Pavilion's wrap-around patio, looking over the zoo's lush greenery. Available for evening receptions, the Rain Forest Food Pavilion is the perfect setting for company receptions, award banquets and fundraisers. For more images see Rain Forest Food Pavilion.

ZOOMAZIUM

This nature-themed indoor play area by day transforms into an uplifting and unique location for a mid-size evening event. Zoomazium offers a fun and whimsical setting that will inspire guests to let loose and enjoy the atmosphere including two slides and a mountain to climb on. TUNDRA CENTER

Located just between our grizzly bear and snowy owl exhibits, the Tundra Center features a hand-painted panoramic mural of the arctic tundra. Your guests will experience the wild from the comfort and warmth of this meeting room. Tundra is available for both daytime and evening events, and can accommodate luncheons and small dinners. COST: \$800 (full trail access, \$1,200)

TAIGA VIEWING SHELTER

Tucked between the grizzly bear and North American river otter exhibits, the Taiga Viewing Shelter immerses your guests in the naturalistic setting of the award-winning Northern Trail. Entertain your guests as the brown bears look on curiously and the otters zip around in the water, mere feet from your group. For more images see Northern Trail.

CAROUSEL

Built in 1918, the Historic Carousel is the perfect backdrop for a cocktail party or evening reception. Your guests will delight in the magic of the carousel lit up in the evening. A party room inside the building provides plenty of room for mingling. The party rooms are also available for daytime rental – ideal for a uniquely atypical meeting location.

CAPACITY: Daytime – 60 (48 seated) in party rooms

Evening – 150 (48 seated) in full building

RENTAL TIME: May-September, Monday through Friday –

9:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. (party rooms only) or 7:00 - 11 p.m. (full building)

 $\textbf{October-April, Monday through Friday} - \ 9:30 \ a.m. - \ 4:00 \ p.m. \ (party \ rooms \ only)$

or 6:00 - 10:00 p.m. (full building, excluding during WildLights)

INCLUDES: 60 wood chairs

BOARDROOM in the Center for Wildlife Conservation

The Center for Wildlife Conservation Boardroom is a classic meeting space that can accommodate any meeting style with A/V needs, food and beverage components and more. Typically used as one large room, the Boardroom can also be separated by an air wall to allow for two meeting spaces.

CAPACITY: 80 (capacity will depend on room setup)

RENTAL TIME: *May-September* – 9:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. or 7:00 - 11:00 p.m.

October-April – 9:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 - 10:00 p.m. (excluding during WildLights)



CLASSROOMS in the Education Center

Woodland Park Zoo's Education Center Classroom allows for meetings, lectures and seminars of all kinds. This large space can be separated by an air wall to accommodate two smaller meeting rooms.

CAPACITY: 100 (capacity will depend on room setup)

RENTAL TIME: May-September – 9:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. or 7:00 - 11:00 p.m.

October-April – 9:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 - 10:00 p.m. (excluding during WildLights)

INCLUDES: Classroom chairs, 6' tables, 8' tables, thin 8' tables

COST: \$500 whole room / \$250 per room

Lancer Catering minimum: No minimum required. Food and beverage must be provided by Lancer Catering. Additional rental equipment (alternative chairs, cocktail tables and A/V needs) available for a fee.

AUDITORIUM in the Education Center

The Education Center's PACCAR Auditorium is a standard theater with 214 chairs equipped with pull up desk tops. The Auditorium comes equipped with a large screen and sound, lighting and computer components.

CAPACITY: 214

RENTAL TIME: May-September – 9:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. or 7:00 - 11:00 p.m.

October-April – 9:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 - 10:00 p.m. (excluding during WildLights)

EVENT INFORMATION

ZOO ADMISSION

Events held after zoo operating hours do not require the purchase of admission tickets as guests remain in the designated venue. Full zoo access is not permitted during after-hours events.

Events held on zoo grounds during operating hours require the purchase of zoo admission tickets for all attendees. We offer the option to pre-purchase tickets in advance or to be post-billed after your event. In either case, the appropriate discount, based on guest count, is applied. Admission tickets are not required for zoo members.

PARKING

Parking in one of the zoo's five parking lots is \$6 per car, \$18 per bus and \$4 per motorcycle during zoo operating hours. Limited street parking is available nearby. Parking in zoo lots is free after 6:00 p.m. from May-September and after 4:00 p.m. from October-April.

SITE RESERVATION AND DEPOSIT

To reserve an event venue, a signed reservation agreement and non-refundable deposit equal to one-half of the venue fee is required.

Venue Reservation Cancellation Policy: Events cancelled 30 days or less from scheduled event date require full payment of venue fee.

RENTAL EQUIPMENT

Some venues come equipped with equipment – see venue information for details. Some events may require additional rental of equipment including tables, chairs, A/V equipment and canopies. Your Group Sales representative will help you determine how much rental equipment is needed and will facilitate the reservation, setup and removal of this equipment. For both rental and A/V equipment, delivery and setup charges apply.

Equipment and Canopy Rental Cancellation Policy: Rental equipment cancellations 14 days or less prior to the event date require full payment of the rental fee.

EVENT INFORMATION

SETUP

Rental time does not include setup and cleanup time. Access to the venue space is provided one hour prior to listed time for setup and one hour after listed time for cleanup.

RESTRICTIONS

For the safety of the animals and fellow zoo visitors, certain items are not allowed on zoo grounds.

Drones, balloons, piñatas, balls, Frisbees and other flying objects, confetti, glitter, clowns, mascots, costumes and other "circus" type items are prohibited. Please consult your Sales & Event Coordinator before bringing items and activities into the zoo.

No vehicles are permitted anywhere on zoo grounds. Large props and items require written permission from your Sales & Event Coordinator before bringing onto zoo grounds.

In compliance with quarantine restrictions and park regulations, pets, skateboards, bicycles and firearms are not allowed at Woodland Park Zoo. Permanent attachment (nails, screws, tacks, tape, wire or staples) of any decor items to any wall or structure is prohibited.

Due to close proximity to animal exhibits, noise restrictions apply in most venues. Your Sales and Event Coordinator must pre-approve all requests for music or audio. Once approved, only light amplification is permitted. Bands and DJs are prohibited in all picnic venues with the exception of the North Meadow pending approval.


