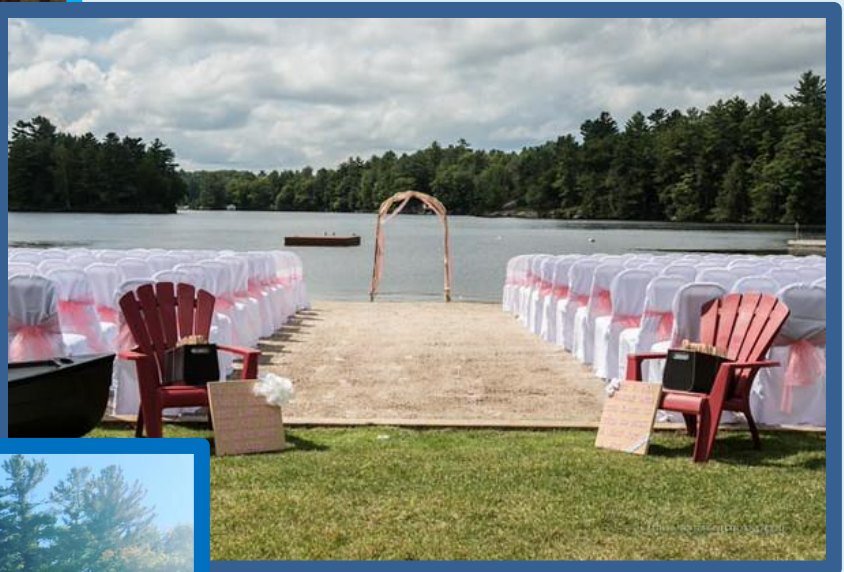

Cottages

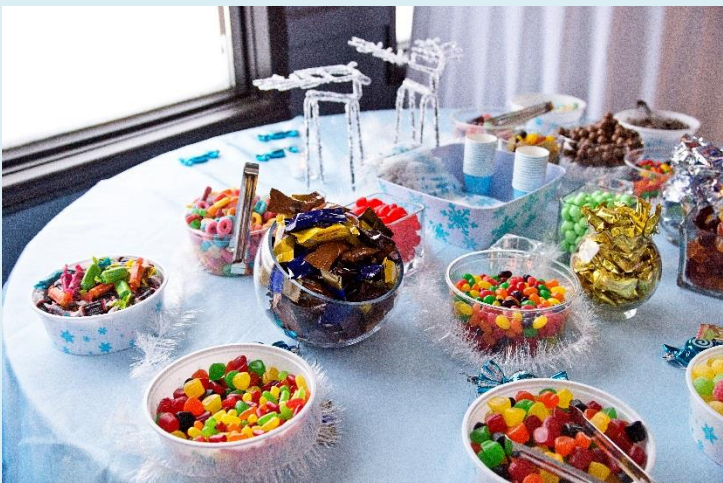

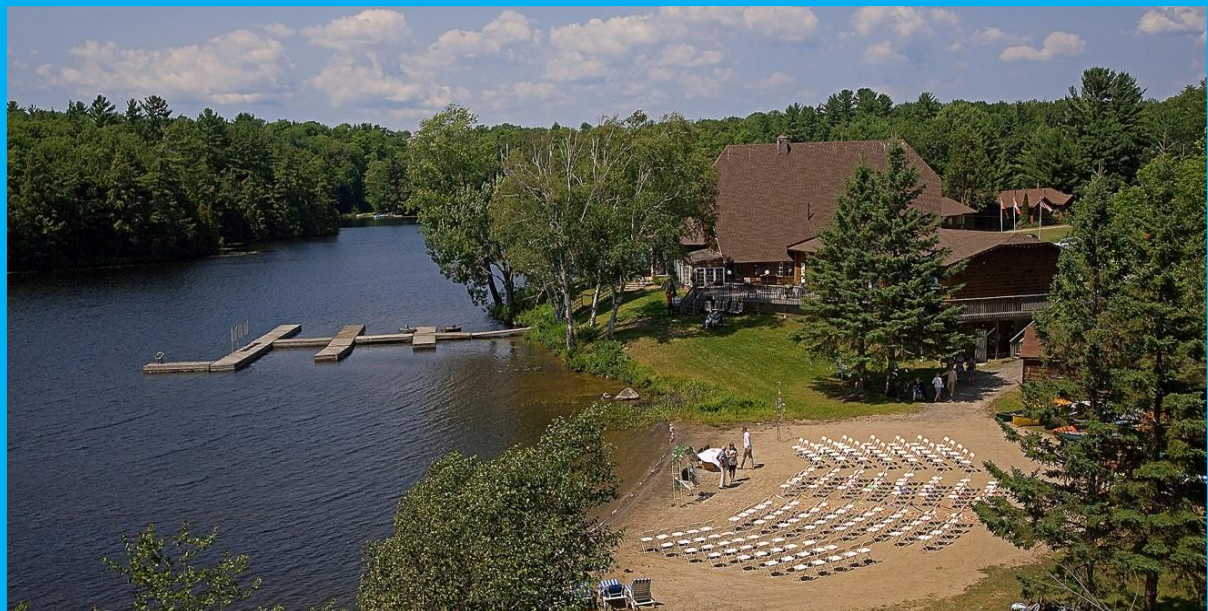

Additional Important Notes

Room block will be released 60 days prior to the function.

Overnight guests will receive 15% off accommodations prior to the block being released.

All food and beverage consumed in any public area on the resort must be purchased through Grand Tappattoo Resort and fall within our Resort Liquor Licence Laws.

There are no pets allowed in any of the guest rooms, cottages or public areas at the resort.

Booking Policy

A non-refundable reservation deposit of \$2000 is required upon the signing of the contract with Grand Tappattoo Resort. 50% of the remaining estimate is due 120 days prior to the event, 50% of the remaining balance is due 60 days prior and the balance is due the day of the event.

A guaranteed number of guests for meals **MUST** be received **NO LATER** than 7 days prior to the function date.

If there is a variance of 10% of the original estimate Grand Tappattoo Resort has the Right to change the location of your ceremony and reception to accommodate appropriately.

Method of payments accepted for initial deposit Cash, Debit, Cheque and major Credit Cards. Future payments may be made by post dated cheque, cash, debit or e-transfer.

Cancellation:

If cancellation occurs between date of signature and date of arrival, the party cancelling the function/item is liable to the other party.

Grand Tappattoo Resort for full refund of deposits and the contract party is liable for 100% of the total value of the guest rooms, accommodations and food and beverage programs, unless the space is resold. The cancellation payment is due upon receipt of written notice of cancellation.

The CLIENT(S) cannot hold Grand Tappattoo Resort responsible for failure to provide the basic facilities and services due to emergencies, catastrophes or interruptions of public utilities.

In the case of a mandatory evacuation at Grand Tappattoo Resort we will allow you to reschedule if possible and/or receive a full refund of the Security Deposit. If an Act of God were to occur preventing the event from taking place as scheduled, Grand Tappattoo Resort will allow for the event to be rescheduled, pending availability, with no penalty. Last minute cancellations of outdoor site due to inclement weather will not be considered.

Directions to Grand Tappattoo

From Toronto

Travel highway 400 north through Barrie towards Parry Sound, once you reach the Parry Sound District take exit 217 from Highway 400. Turn Left on Oastler Park Drive and continue approximately 2 kilometers. Turn left on James Bay Junction Road and continue 500 meters across the train tracks. Turn left on Otter Lake Road and continues 3 kilometers then turn right on Tapattoo Trail and follow until you reach the resort.

From Sudbury

Travel south on Highway 69 which becomes Highway 400 in Parry Sound. Bypass Parry Sound and continue to Exit 217. Take Exit 217 and turn right on Oastler Park Drive and continue approximately 2 kilometers. Turn left on James Bay Junction Road and continue 500 meters across the train tracks. Turn left on Otter Lake Road and continues 3 kilometers then turn right on Tapattoo Trail and follow until you reach the resort.
