Recommended for children under 3.

Recommended for ages 3 and up.

Take care of your farm by doing farm chores such as feeding the chickens, milking Buttermilk the incredible milking cow, and washing clothes.

General Policies

The HFM is not responsible for anyone injured on the premises or for personal property left on this site. Individuals or organizations renting the facilities for children's birthday parties at HFM agree to assume all responsibility and liability for damages done to buildings or to its contents by themselves, members, or guests.

Facility

Our facility includes a pole barn equipped with lighting, ceiling fans, and picnic tables or round tables. The pole barn is not climate controlled. We have a multi-purpose meadow ideal for all types of party games. **We encourage all party guests to wear closed-toed shoes when on the Farmstead.

Decorations

Decorations or signs may not be affixed to any structure, object or collection item with any damaging substance. Free-standing decorations or those suitable are allowed. The party host is allowed on the grounds 30 minutes prior to the party to decorate. All decorations must be removed upon conclusion of the party. Piñatas and balloons are NOT allowed inside the Farmstead; however, you may put balloons on the entrance gate to designate entrance for party guests. Decorations or other items may not be brought in and stored over night.

Food

Food is not provided with any of the options. You are invited to bring your own refreshments, food or cake. There are tables in the pole barn to use for food and refreshments.

Animals

All parties include the opportunity to see our animals, including: the chickens, turkeys, guinea fowls, goats and sheep. Although we do not have a "Petting Zoo," the animals are fenced and can be SEEN by the visitors.

Clean-Up

Party host is responsible for cleaning the grounds and buildings used. The grounds must be left clear of decorations, litter and other debris. Trash should be placed in the bins provided, including recycling. If serving trays containing water are used, the water should be emptied behind or on the side of the barn facility and not directly in front of the barn.

Smoking and Pets

HFM is a smoke-free facility and smoking is prohibited on the grounds. Pets are not allowed on the grounds at any time unless prior permission is granted.

Rain and Cancellation Policy

There are no refunds for Birthday Parties. HFM will always attempt to accommodate the renter by offering an alternative date. Unless the renter expresses to not go through with the party, the outdoor activities of the birthday party will be performed in the rain. In the event of lightening or substantial rain, the HFM will provide indoor activities and programs for the guests in the pole barn if the outdoor activities cannot be performed.
