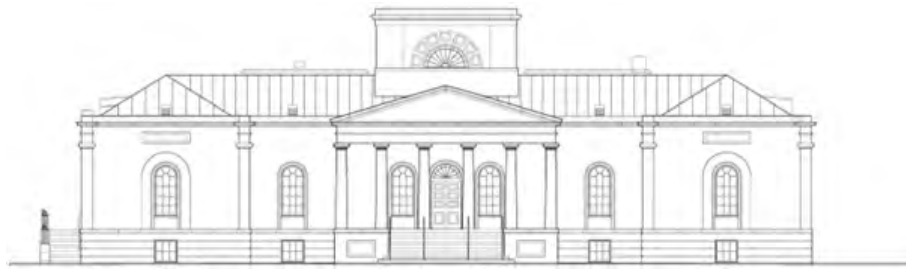


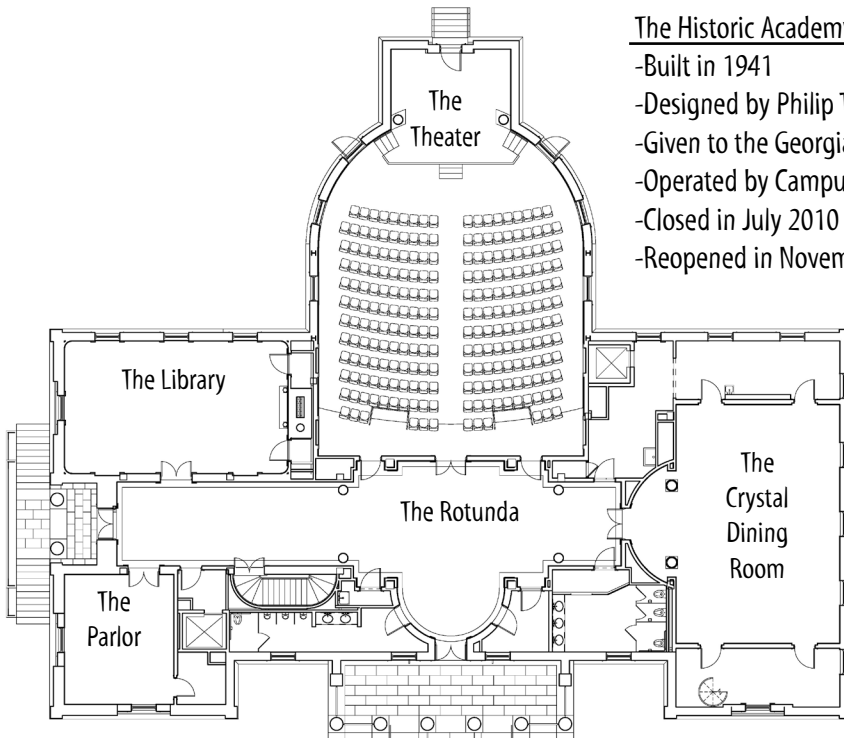

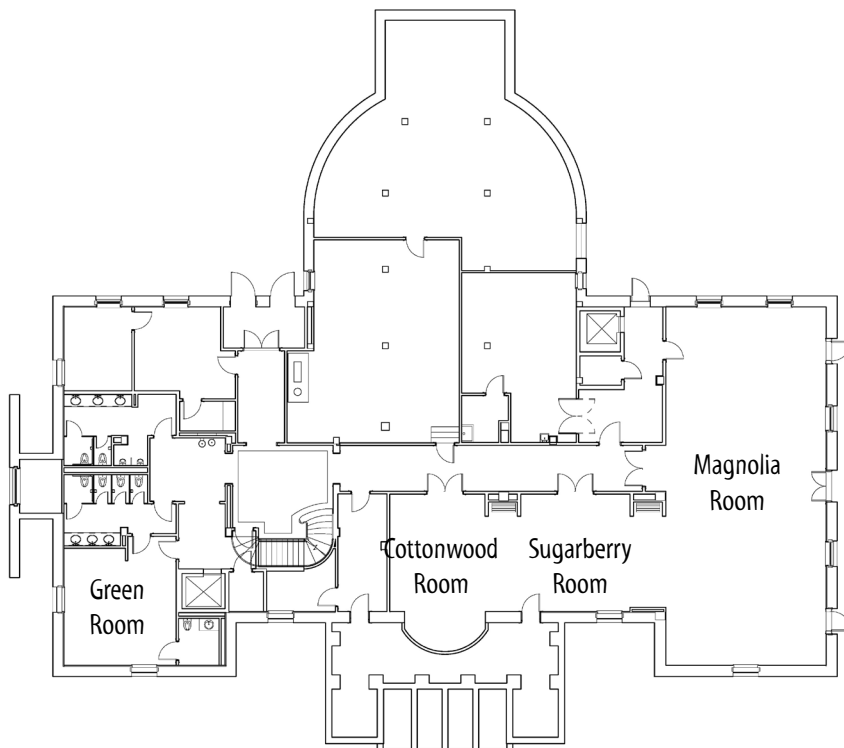
## The Historic Academy of Medicine

- Built in 1941
- Designed by Philip Trammell Shutze
- Given to the Georgia Tech Foundation in 2008
- Operated by Campus Services
- Closed in July 2010 for restoration efforts
- Reopened in November 2011



## The Upper Level

- 3 Unique meeting rooms
  - Crystal Dining Room (seating for 80, banquet rounds)
  - Library (seating for 50, banquet rounds)
  - Parlor (seating for 20, banquet rounds)
- 230 seat Theater
- Grand central Rotunda with black and white Italian marble flooring
- Private catering kitchen
- Beautiful front portico



## The Terrace Level

- 3 Unique meeting rooms or 1 contiguous room
  - Magnolia Room (seating for 120, banquet rounds)
  - Sugarberry Room (seating for 30, banquet rounds)
  - Cottonwood Room (seating for 20, banquet rounds)
  - Grand Magnolia Room (seating for 170, banquet rounds)
- Private catering kitchen
- Charming outdoor terrace (seating for 120, banquet rounds)
- Private Room – to be used as office/space or event Green Room
