

## HOW ARE WE DIFFERENT?

# HOW DO WE DO IT?

So how do we pull off a surprising, engaging murder mystery dinner show for your group, if everyone in the room already knows everyone else?

#### 1. THEY TRUST YOU!

By having you and a few members of your group meet with The Dinner Detective cast before the event, it's easy for you to become accomplices in the mystery. We use your guests' sense of trust in you to our advantage. Each co-conspirator will work with a cast member to formulate a background story summarizing how you know one another, when you first met, and other key details. This background story will be a key ingredient to pulling off your acquaintanceship with this particular cast member. By introducing an actor to someone in your party as a friend, acquaintance or distant relative, you give them a legitimate reason to be at your function. You'd be surprised how easily your guests will buy your story!

### 2. PERSONALIZED GOSSIP (A.K.A. "DIRT")

Another way we customize and add a sense of personalization to the script is to acquire as much "dirt" on the most outgoing members of your group as possible, and paint a cloud of suspicion over them throughout the evening. Once we establish a sense of guilt in the air, we can roast these individuals throughout the evening.

"Dirt" is information about the people who will be attending. Their job titles, funny habits or any hobbies that seem odd or may stand out (i.e. the serial dater, the office gossip, the knowit-all, the American Idol wannabe, the fast car nut, the overachiever, the slacker and so on).

For example, let's say you'd like to integrate the company president or a fun spirited relative into the show. By getting your hands on their business card, company letterhead or (even better) a picture of them, we can work it as a clue into the plot, implicating them in one of our murders and using the personal information you gave us to roast them even further. The surprised reaction he or she and the rest of the group will get when that piece of evidence is found on the murder victim is often priceless.

We also love any sort of "lingo" or terminology you or your group may use on a daily basis. If you are in an area of expertise or work in a field that has specific terms used, we would love to know what they are and how they are used. Bringing the show to a level of knowledge you and your co-workers can understand makes it all the more fun. All of this is done in good clean fun, and our experience in the past has shown us that people love to be implicated or involved in the action.
