


**Congratulations on your engagement**, and thank you for your interest in Cedar Mountain Farm! We would love nothing more than to be part of your wedding.

# **CEDAR MOUNTAIN FARM AT A GLANCE**


**Location:** Rapidan, Virginia; an hour and a half outside Washington, D.C.

**Event Capacity:** The Farm can host indoor events of up to 150 guests in the Red Barn, and indoor-outdoor events of up to 300 guests.



### **THE RED BARN**






Patio area can be completely enclosed/tented at additional cost. Overheard patio deck will be constructed in Spring of 2020.






# THE GUEST HOUSE

The Guest House is a mid-century modern-style dwelling and event space, ideal for hosting dinner parties and overnight Farm stays. For the latter, the space sleeps up to 6 guests, and is ideal for getting ready on your wedding day.

The adjoining Patio is an intimate dining area, perfect for alfresco entertaining. It may be utilized in conjunction with the Guest House or separately. The Guest House can accommodate up to 27 guests, and even more if the Patio is used as well.







### **THE WILLOWS**




Our lush willow tree grove provides a natural canopy perfect for a romantic summer wedding ceremony or picnic. This space easily accommodates 150 guests or more.

We are happy to provide fee information for a larger party upon request. In addition, we work with a number of vendors and would be pleased to offer you a pricing range for other rental needs.

Please note: If you would like to serve alcohol, you will be required to obtain an ABC one-day license, which is easy to do and inexpensive. If you are interested, we are happy to send you a step-by-step guide to obtaining this license.

Our rental fees are based on a 10-hour day and include tables and chairs for 150 people. As we only host one wedding per day, any and all of our event spaces on the Farm may be utilized.

\*Day of wedding coordinator is required.



#### Can I take photos with the Farm animals?

We are more than happy to assist you and your photographer in getting the perfect shot with our animals as a backdrop. However, for safety reasons we can't allow you to enter the paddock.

#### Can I use the vintage car in my photos?

Yes! Our 1929 Chevy is available for rental for photo shoots.

### Can I bring my pets on the farm?

We love animals—but we are also a working farm. For your pets' safety, we ask that you leave your pets at home. Registered service dogs are allowed.

#### Are open sparklers or flame candles permitted to use?

Due to the historic nature of our buildings, we do not allow sparklers or open flame candles.

### How late can the party go?

Culpeper County requires that all outside music end at 10:30 pm. Indoor weddings and events must be over by 11:00 pm.
