

Event & Meeting Venues

The Main Hall

The TGCA Main Hall is the perfect place for fundraisers, company gatherings and parties, weddings, tradeshows and so much more. With over 10,000 square feet of unrestricted floor space, it's one of the largest multi-functional community halls in Calgary and can accommodate up to 800 guests.

The Main Hall measures 148' x 72' and comes equipped with a 12' x 24' stage rising 40" above the floor.

Rental Fee 250-500 guests \$1375 501-800 guests \$1700 Damage deposit is equal to rental fee

There is a corkage fee which is **mandatory** for any event serving liquor and **all** weekend events, and there is a minimum charge for 250 people, regardless of the number of expected guests you may expect at your event.

The corkage fee includes the following: pop, juice, ice, plastic glasses, bartending staff, setup and tear down, and cleanup.

Alcohol service corkage: \$4.75 per person

Non-alcohol service corkage: \$3.25 per person

Kitchen Use

The kitchen is directly adjacent to the Main Hall, and has 2 over-sized ovens, a 6-burner range, a flat-top grill, and 1 large refrigerator available to rental events.

Option 1

Storage/Warm and Serve only, \$170. This option includes the use of the adjacent kitchen space for the storage of the food you are providing and the use of the ovens for warming only during the day's event.

Option 2

Prepare and cook food (using base ovens only), \$400.

This option offers full access to the rental kitchen facilities.

Additional kitchen options: (Must be a licenced catering company) one convection oven \$100 Deep fryer option \$400 (includes ZTF oil).

All prices are subject to GST.

Rental fee and additional fees, as well as the floor plan are due two weeks prior to the function.

Prices are in effect as of Sept. 1 2019.

LIQUOR

Renter supplies liquor and liquor licence and offers either a no host bar or a cash bar with the rentee retaining 100% of the profits.

In accordance with AGLC regulations, when liquor is served, hot or cold food items (prepared in a licensed facility) must be offered for patron consumption

Liquor sales must **end by 1:00 am** with consumption until one hour after end of liquor service.



The Thorncliffe Room

Located on the main floor of the community centre, the Thorncliffe Room can accommodate 125 people in comfort. The room is equipped with two semi-private entrances, washroom, bar, liquor coolers, stage, and kitchen facilities. See page 12 for catering options.

Option 1 (Alcohol being served)

Bartender(s): \$19/hour Corkage: \$4.75/person

Corkage is based on a minimum charge of 75 people. Your corkage fee will include the following: pop, juice, ice, plastic glasses, candles, paper tablecloths and general clean up. Note that if your event has over 100 people in attendance, we recommend 2 bartenders.

Option 2 (No Alcohol being served)

Staff on Site: \$19/hour

One of the two above options must be chosen.

All prices are subject to GST. Rental fee and additional fees, as well as the floor plan are due two weeks prior to the function. Prices are in effect as of September 1, 2019.



Meeting Rooms



Boardroom

This room is ideal for business or organization meetings. With 20 comfortable rolling chairs, a projector screen, plenty of available privacy, and space for a lunch or dinner spread. Collaborations and larger meetings are productive, and easily accommodated in this space.

Non-prime-time: \$40/hour tax (7:00 am-5:00 pm)

Prime-time: \$50/hour + tax (5:00 pm-10:00 pm)

5600 Room

Self-contained with its own bar, coolers and washrooms, there is sufficient seating for 30 people. This space is perfect for small gatherings like showers and anniversary parties. This room can be licensed for liquor service, which will require a TGCA bartender.

Non-prime-time: \$40.00 + tax (7:00 am-5:00 pm) Prime-time: \$50.00/hour + tax (5:00 pm-10:00

Afternoon or evening party rate: \$175.00 Bartender (Alcohol served): \$19/hr






Horizon Room



Leagues

Register for Men's and Women's Fall Racquetball at the TGCA.

Racquetball is a great way to get your heart rate up, stay fit, and get out and meet new people!

The leagues are on Monday & Wednesday of each week from 5:00 pm until 9:00 pm (depending on how many players sign up (sometimes there is a 4:30 start time). Some players only play Mondays, some only play Wednesdays, but a lot play both nights. The cost of each league is \$110 plus \$10 for snacks & prizes on each windup night (for a total of \$120).

There are three divisions on Mondays (A1 – Advanced, A2 – intermediate & B1 – beginner to intermediate). Wednesday has the same three plus and additional one for elite players called A1 Plus. There are two leagues per year, one in January and one in Sept. Each league runs for 14 weeks, the last of which is a fun night which we call windup.

There is a semi playoff between the top four players in a division, then players five to eight and so on. Unfortunately, people cannot drop in as all schedules are set. If anyone gets hurt or drops out, there will be replacement players sought.

The leagues are open to both male & female players. All players typically have their own equipment, but you can also rent goggles and racquets at The 56. Inquire with the bartender.
