Each wedding is as unique as the couple getting married and, as such, we don't limit our services to a list of tasks. We will work tirelessly and with our considerable talents and experience, to make sure your wedding goes according to plan. Here's how we work for day-of coordination.

### STEP ONE - INITIAL CONSULTATION

We know, you want a price, but your wedding is so important that we want to know exactly how we can help you make it come together. We're happy to meet with you at your convenience to hear about your vision and get to know you a little bit

#### STEP TWO - PROPOSAL

We will put together a customized proposal for you. If you decide to add more elements, we're happy to revise it at any time. If you decide to cut out some tasks, that's fine too. Our proposal is a starting place.

### STEP THREE - CONTRACT

After we agree on exactly the services you want, we'll give you a contract with standard terms that outline exactly what we're going to do and what we require from you. Upon signing the contract, we'll hold the date on our calendar for you. We require a \$500 non-refundable deposit at this time.

### STEP FOUR - COMMUNICATION

Depending on the service you want, we'll begin communicating with you about vendors, timelines,

recommendations, etc. You'll probably hear from us way more than you want to! We may be touring venues with you or consulting with caterers or florists, reviewing contracts to make sure nothing is slipping through the cracks.

### STEP FIVE - FINAL WALK-THROUGH

About four to six weeks before your wedding, we will set up a final walk-through with you, your family members, wedding party, vendors ~ whoever you want to invite. At this time we will go over your timeline (usually there is a Master Timeline for days before the wedding through the day itself and a more detailed Ceremony Timeline for the ceremony). By the time you leave the final walk-through, you should be confident that all your vendors understand what to do and where to be. We want you to enjoy the last few weeks before your wedding celebrating with friends and family and not worrying about the wedding details.

### STEP SIX - WEDDING DAY

We'll be your resource from beginning to end.

#### STEP SEVEN - FINAL PAYMENT

The balance of your contract is not due until the wedding is over. We want you to be satisfied with all of our services before you complete your payment.
