

The Aviary. (1) A former Aviary transformed into a two-story suite with a private covered terrace. The downstairs living room features windows on all sides and a BeoVision 9-50 Entertainment System. The Terrace Suite. (1) A ground floor suite with mountain vista. The sitting area is enclosed in bronze, glass, and brick and opens to a 40 foot covered private portico. The spacious bedroom features a king size bed, a BeoVision 7-40 Entertainment System, and a bathroom with an imported antique soaking tub and large shower.

Junior Suites with Balcony. (4) Grand rooms with high ceilings, beautiful views, and wonderful architectural details.
