## **LOWER LEVEL COURT AND CAFÉ 7**

**DINNER: 200, RECEPTION: 300**

Reached by descending a floating staircase, the Court area features distinctive architectural concrete and granite finishes that distinguish this unique space. High ceilings and an open floorplan make it well suited for a variety of uses.

## **MICHAEL CONFORTI PAVILION AND TERRACE**

**DINNER: 150, RECEPTION: 180**

This 3,200-square-foot glass pavilion, offering flexible multi-use space, is located on the upper level of the Clark Center overlooking the one-acre reflecting pool and scenic hillside.

## **MUSEUM PAVILION AND TERRACE**

**DINNER: 65, RECEPTION: 65**

The dramatic glass and marble Museum Pavilion offers sweeping views of the tranquil reflecting pool and the award-winning landscape.

## **LUNDER CENTER AND MOLTZ TERRACE**

**DINNER: 50 (indoor), RECEPTION: 100 (outdoor)**

Located at the summit of a winding woodland path, the Lunder Center at Stone Hill provides indoor and outdoor function spaces. The Hunter Studio space is ideal for intimate events, while the Moltz Terrace affords magnificent views of the Taconic Range and creates an exceptional party space.

## VENUE RENTAL FEES

Below is a list of currently available spaces for rent at the Clark Art Institute. All fees include a charitable gift to the Clark. Rentals are available to Clark Society members only; new members are always welcome.

### LUNDER CENTER AND MOLTZ TERRACE

**DINNER:** 50 (indoor)  
**RECEPTION:** 100 (outdoor)  
**FEE:** \$7,500  
Includes venue rental (\$2,500)  
and Clark Society Curators Circle membership (\$5,000)

Discounted rates available for non-profit organizations.  
Tables in the Clark's current inventory are included. All other items must be rented.

A \$1,000 charge will be added to the venue rental fee for wedding ceremonies.

The Clark charges usage fees to cover setup and breakdown, cleaning, restroom attendants, and security. Gallery admission can be arranged if desired, with preferred pricing. Catering, décor, and rentals other than the Clark's tables are provided separately by Constellation Culinary Group.

**LOW SEASON (January–March)** Venue rental fees are reduced by 20%

**HIGH SEASON (Memorial Day Weekend–Labor Day Weekend)** Venue rental fees are increased by 20%

Please note: Availability of rental spaces during summer season is dependent upon museum exhibition schedule. Prices valid as of October 15, 2018.
