Caples House Museum



Built in 1870 by Dr. Charles Caples, this house served as the home and office for this 19th century country doctor. Given by his descendants to the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) it was reconditioned and opened to the public in 1970 by the DAR.

The apple and pear orchard is a designated Heritage Orchard over 150 years old. The former carriage house was converted to a children's museum. A walk through this area often brings nostalgia for our childhood days. Also enjoy the collection of First Lady dolls in their inaugural gowns.





Weddings and receptions in the gardens are available for up to 150 guests. Indoor weddings can accommodate up to 51 guests banquet style and 110 using theater style. The Cottage can accommodate 16 people banquet style or 34 people using theater style.

Event packages include:

- Ample parking,
- Several ceremony sites to choose from,
- ♦ Bride's dressing room,
- Flexible set up and clean up options available for an additional charge.
