## VENUE OVERVIEW

From intimate wedding ceremonies to elegant receptions, the Japanese Friendship Garden is the perfect setting for any celebration.

Clients can rent either the entire Upper Garden or Lower Garden for their event(s). Each venue has its own unique areas that are listed below and explained in further detail in the following pages.

### UPPER GARDEN VENUE (UG)

Filled with luscious green scenery, the Upper Garden has unique settings for events that are outdoors. The Upper Garden areas include:

- Koi Pond & Moon Viewing Deck
- Ceremonial Gate
- Reception Plaza
- Bonsai Exhibit
- Exhibit Hall\*
- Activity Room (Bridal Prep Room)
- Two single stalled bathrooms (gender neutral/ handicap accessible)



### LOWER GARDEN VENUE (LG)

## INAMORI PAVILION

The Inamori Pavilion is an indoor space with an outdoor feel, perfect for receptions. The location could also work great for a ceremony as well. Area includes a deck for guests to walk around, enjoying the gorgeous scenery and waterfall.

#### **CAPACITY**

Seated Reception: 200 (+30 if no dance floor) (+50 if Ceremony off-site) Cocktail Reception: 300 Ceremony: 250 (Room can be divided in half for small events)

# PAVILION COURTYARD

This area, located right outside the Inamori Pavilion, is a great spot for outdoor events. The Pavilion Courtyard also serves as the main site for ceremonies.

#### **CAPACITY**

Ceremony: 250 Seated Reception: 100 Cocktail Reception: 250

This outdoor deck of the Inamori Pavilion is an ideal place to walk around for cocktail hour. Guests can enjoy the gorgeous scenery and waterfall of the Lower Garden.

# GARDEN PATHS & EARTH BRIDGE

Our Lower Gardens include a beautiful path where guests can stroll during their cocktail hour exploring a variety of plants and flowers along side a charming stream.

Our Earth Bridge can also serve as an exquisite ceremony spot for those interested in intimate weddings. Guests are only allowed to stand during the ceremony, except for those who are handicapped. It's also the perfect place for photos after the ceremony

Seated Ceremony: 80-120 (+40 picnic seating and/or standing)

# KOI POND & MOON VIEWING DECK

Nestled beneath the *fujidana* (wisteria arbor) and surrounded by the serene sounds of the waterfall, the Koi Pond is a favorite spot for wedding ceremonies and cocktail receptions.

#### **CAPACITY**

Ceremony: 85 Cocktail Reception: 150 (200 when Exhibit Hall is also rented)

## CEREMONIAL GATE

The majestic backdrop of the Charles C. Dail Memorial Gate is the perfect location for large ceremonies and cocktail receptions.

The Ceremonial Gate is a magnificent location surrounded by trees with a view of the towering Corinthian columns of the Spreckels Organ Pavilion.

#### CAPACITY

Ceremony: 100 (+200 extended seating)

Cocktail Reception: 200

# RECEPTION PLAZA

Our open air Reception Plaza is the perfect spot for a reception under the stars. The area includes a deck overlooking the plaza that can be used as an entertainment stage. Spring events can enjoy wisteria blossoms on the wooden *fujidana* (arbor).

Seated Reception: 200 Cocktail Reception: 300

## EXHIBIT Hall

Designed in traditional Japanese *sukiya* style, the Exhibit Hall features rotating exhibits of art, historical artifacts, and collections from Japanese culture. Guests can enjoy the season's featured exhibit and viewing room of the Dry Rock Garden.

#### CAPACITY

Ceremony: 30 Cocktail Reception: 40

Additional fee with private event rental: \$120/hr





## ACTIVITY ROOM

This multi-use room can be used for meetings, classes, and small indoor events.\*

#### **CAPACITY**

Seated Reception: 40 Classroom: 50

#### **FEATURES**

Conference table for 12
Kimono display

Additional chairs and tables available for rent.

#### RENTAL FEE

- Included free with Upper Garden Private Event Rental -During Public Hours this space is rentable for \$100/ hour plus admission (group discounts apply).

#### SUGGESTED HOURS

Wedding Ceremony only: 3 hours Ceremony & Reception: 7-9 hours Reception only: 6-8 hours

All set up and clean up must occur during rented hours

#### **VENUE RENTAL INCLUDES:**

- Exclusive access to all outdoor spaces in either the Upper Garden or Lower Garden
- 30 minutes for Upper Garden and 1 hour for Lower Garden of free set up with minimum rental.
- 1 hour of rehearsal time for wedding ceremonies
- JFG Event Staff support during the scheduled event
- 1 hour photoshoot time prior to the event
- A separate free 3 hour period for market light set up.

#### **FVFNT RESTRICTIONS**

- Events must be scheduled after Garden's operational hours
- Set up may begin as early as 3:30 pm in the Upper Gardne & 3:00 pm in the Lower Garden.
- Earliest guest entry is 5:00 pm
- All Events must end by 12:00 am midnight
- Clean up must be complete by 1:00 am for UG and 1:30 am for LG
- All decor must be submitted to and approved by Japanese Friendship Garden Event Coordinator.
- Vendors and Special Event clients are responsible for set-up and cleanup of the event.

#### **BOOKING**

- Japanese Friendship Garden membership is required to host event at the Garden. Memberships start at \$60.
- To officially reserve an event date the client(s) must submit:
  - Signed Event Contracts
  - Security Staffing Fee
  - JFG Membership Fee
  - 50% of the hourly rental rate

#### FOOD & DRINK

- Private Event Rental clients are required to choose from our list of Preferred Caterers.
- Inquire with caterers for catering pricing information.
- Alcohol must be served by a licensed & insured beverage service.

#### **EQUIPMENT RENTALS**

- The Garden has limited equipment rentals
- Linens, lighting, dance floors and other equipment should be secured through a rental company or one of our preferred caterers. You may also rent chairs and tables from them or if you choose to, rent them from us.

#### ETC.

- Military discount for active duty military & veterans.
- Discount available for 501(c)(3) Non-profits events.
- LGBT friendly event venue
