



White Acres Farms Barn Wedding & Event Venue



The White Acres Farms wedding and event venue is a sincere labor of love that is family owned and operated. It is conveniently located near the Lake Martin area within 30 minutes from Auburn, an hour from Montgomery and two hours from Birmingham. We purchased the 100 acres of wooded property in 2004 and began development while utilizing the trees to build structures for various farm animals, covered bridges, and barns to accommodate our collection of reclaimed wood that we

obtained from old homes and buildings. We stumbled upon an old red barn from the 1800's on a plantation along the Troy highway that had been torn down and we decided to purchase it. The red barn was relocated to White Acres and was reconstructed into a beautiful repurposed barn providing the perfect venue to host receptions and events. Our reception barn is 8,000 square feet which is climate controlled, decorated with beautiful crystal chandeliers, while offering a catering preparation kitchen and full bar.

The 5,000 square feet ceremony barn began as a storage facility for our reclaimed wood collection and farm equipment. When our son and Fiancé became engaged, they decided to have their wedding with wonderful views and a stunning sunset while creating a vintage elegant ambiance and we were honored they chose our farm. The ceremony barn quickly progressed into a rustic, worshipful wedding chapel refined with reclaimed wood church pews and crystal chandeliers.

White Acres Farms has become a “dream come true” for us and we are thrilled to share our dream with you. Our brides, grooms, and families tell us that they feel like they are a part of our family by the time their wedding day approaches. We adore our couples and treasure the relationship we develop with them over the course of their wedding planning. We continue to perform improvements and additions to our venue to make it a special place where our clients can create their dream wedding with memories that will last a lifetime.

Booking Information: A deposit of \$1,500 is required to book your requested date(s); however, an Event date is not confirmed until we have received a signed White Acres Farm Special Events and Wedding Venue Contract. You will have access to start decorating beginning Friday morning the day before the wedding at 8 a.m. You will be renting the venue beginning Saturday morning and until 11 p.m. It includes the use of the Chapel Barn for the wedding ceremony rehearsal on Friday afternoon or evening. Once you rent the venue you have access to the property for your photo shoots of “save the date” and bridal portraits prior to the wedding.

Hours of Operations: We operate year-round. The rental is from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. on the day of the event. Music and serving of alcohol must end at 10:30 P.M. with major clean up and shut down completed by 11:00 P.M.

The Reception Barn: The reception barn is heated and cooled and has a lobby, a commercial bar and catering preparation kitchen and includes crystal chandeliers, party lights, tables (*15 six feet round tables that seat 10 & 28 five feet round tables that seat 8*) and 350 white event chairs, food display tables, cake tables, sign in tables, antique mantels and various antique props, restrooms, antique cars & trucks to set the scene and for sendoff. Table cloths are available for rental for \$10 each. The rental fee includes all setup and breakdown of our property as well as clean up. You will be responsible for the breakdown and removal of your decorations and personal property brought to the venue.



The Chapel Barn: The chapel barn is a quaint open-air chapel with seating for around 300 people on pews under cover. Large ceiling fans can be used to keep you cool during the warmer months. For the colder months, we include two 7-foot propane heaters. The stage in the front of the chapel has plenty of room for a large wedding party. The Chapel Barn includes a cross, stage, crystal chandeliers, old antique church pews, antique barrels, mantels, various antique props, burlap draping, and restrooms. Please be courteous and use your time appropriately. Ceremony rehearsals are meant to be used as such, limited to 1 hour.

The Ceremony Hall: The Ceremony Hall is adjacent to the Chapel Barn and is climate controlled with air conditioning and heat. This charming area can be used for rehearsal dinner with seating up to 40 guests for an additional fee for \$750. Restrooms are located nearby. There are 2 large TV's for viewing slide show presentations and videos.

Car Museum: The car museum was built to house our personal collection of trucks and cars as well as vintage gas pumps, signage and vending machines. The interior of the museum is finished in reclaimed wood and materials to maintain the integrity of the rustic nature of our venue. The climate controlled facility has become the perfect space for hosting rehearsal dinners for an additional fee for \$750.

Bridal Party Dressing Room: The Bridal Suite located in the Car Museum is a perfectly appointed room for the bride and her attendants to prepare and savor with anticipation, the upcoming day. This room features nine beautiful antique vanities for hair and make-up, a full length mirror front vintage armoire, garment rack, stand garment steamer, and a television.



Lounge Room in The Car Museum: This room is available for your guest to be used during the reception for those who need a quieter place. It is furnished with antique sofas, artwork, and courting chair. The Reception will be streamed live in this room so guest will not miss out on Reception activities.

Groomsman area in The Ceremony Hall: The groom and his party can relax while they wait for the big event. Restrooms are nearby for party to get dressed. It is simply a great place for the guys to hangout.

Outdoor Fireplace: The outdoor fireplace is a place for guests to take a moment to gather around to look at the stars amidst the crackling fire and relax. (Perhaps you would like to bring a S'more bar?) This area is the only designated smoking area. There is no open flame, of any kind within the barns or facilities, except here at the outdoor fireplace.

Decorations: Renters are required to bring their own decorations and are the renter's responsibility. All decorative materials must be approved by the Venue. We do have various props that you can use. We ask that you do not use artificial florals, etc. that will be left on the ground. No rice, confetti, or glitter are allowed inside or outside the Barn Area. These are harmful, rather than helpful, to our natural surroundings and animals. We request that LED candles be used in the barn area.

Music - DJ or Band: This is another way to reflect your personalities as a couple and make your wedding reception interactive. Be sure the performers, whether DJ or a live band, take requests from the guests for the most fun! We provide a stage area and electrical outlets that can be used and specified by the DJ or Band.

Audio Visual Equipment: We provide a Flat Screen TV that can be used for slideshow presentation or video. Renter must bring their own USB thumb drive, or computer with HDIM Cable. We highly encourage you to bring your video by prior and test it out before the evening of your event.

Parking: There is a designated parking area on the side of the venue for the wedding party only and handicapped. All other parking will be on Ross Road. Please follow the direction of the parking attendant on duty. Parking arrangements for service vehicles such as catering, food trucks, and delivery trucks must be made in advance with the Event Coordinator and all vehicles must be removed two hours prior to event to ensure safety of all guests!
