Libations & Toasts

The Sanguinetti House Museum holds a State of Arizona liquor license, offering convenient alcohol serving options for your guests. Simply set a budget (reserve) for liquor. Once your reserve has been met, you will have the option to add additional funds *or* transition to a cash bar where guests will be welcome to purchase additional alcohol from the Arizona Historical Society.

- A variety of libation options will be offered, including: domestic and import beers, wine, and select mixed drinks
- All alcoholic beverage are priced at \$6 each
- Bartending services are \$40/hour with one additional hour for setup
- Champagne for toasts, \$10-\$15 per bottle *Kindly, bring champagne glasses.*
- Please plan to bring bottled water and non-alcoholic beverages for your guests! Our bartender will be happy to serve.

Notes ~

Payment of the liquor reserve is due at least 30-days prior to your special event. Alcohol is non-cancellable and non-refundable as of one-week prior to the event. Unconsumed liquor is non-refundable and may not leave the premises. Liquor service will be closed 30-minutes prior to the conclusion of your event in accordance with State of Arizona law. All liquor must be purchased through the Arizona Historical Society.

- Tables and chairs are set up by museum staff for your convenience. You have fun decorating!
- Amenities such as linens, additional tents, outdoor heaters, table decorations are not provided.
- Up to 100 white padded chairs, 10, 6ft rectangular tables, and 1 tabletop bar are included at no cost to you with our congratulations!
 - Please provide linen for tabletop bar to match your event color pallette (8 ft table)
- Cleaning cherubs are happy helpers who will clean gardens following your event. Simply take home decorations, valuables, and food items. You relax and enjoy the evening while our cherubs tidy up the museum! \$75-\$300
- Event insurance is required. We make this simple! \$150-\$350
