Trinity Hall Rental Instructions

- No smoking in the hall or within 15 feet of any door or window
 Grounds outside must be left free of cigarettes and litter
- Furniture is not to be removed from the hall
- Alcohol If sold at event, requires Temporary Liquor Permit
- Insurance Certificate covering sale of alcohol
- Sound curfew: 10:00 pm
- Guests are expected to respect property rights and rights to quiet of neighbors
- Monitor parking lot during and after event for excessive noise
- NO FIRES!NO CANDLES!
- Cleaned, folded, stacked and returned to original storage areas No nails, pins or tacks in walls or ceilings
- Use blue painters' tape only, completely removed and area cleaned of adhesives
- Hardwood swept (and damp mopped, if necessary)
 Kitchen floor swept (and damp mopped, if necessary)
 Note: Help us preserve hardwood floors: use caution at all times. Mop must be cleaned and rinsed. Mops are to be left spread to dry.

- Counters, sinks, refrigerator cleaned
- Dishes, cookware, utensils (etc.) washed, returned to original storage areas Stove turned off and cleaned; coffee machines unplugged
- NO FOOD left in kitchen without prior approval •Completely removed from Center
- All Center trash cans relined
- Remove all trash from the Trinity Hall
- All Trash & Recycle bottles and cans Completely removed from Trinity Hall
- Heat turned off
- All lights turned off
- All doors & windows closed & locked
