Frequently Asked Questions

Which parts of the Barn come with my rental?

Your rental includes the use of the main Barn area and loft, the "wagon room," private dressing room, restrooms, and catering kitchen.

Is alcohol and/or smoking allowed in the Barn?

Alcohol may be *served*, *but not sold*, in the Alexander Majors Barn. To serve alcohol at your event, a bartender licensed in the state of Missouri must serve all alcohol, including drink for toasts, etc.. Security is required for all events involving alcohol.

The Alexander Majors House Museum & Barn is a non-smoking facility. Attendees of private events may smoke in their vehicles, but all cigarette/cigar butts and other garbage must be picked up and deposited in the dumpster by the end of the event.

Is the Barn heated & cooled?

Yes! Temperature control is available in all areas of the Barn.

Can I use the Majors grounds for my event, and/or can I set up a tent on the grounds?

Yes! Your event rental includes the use of the grounds. We also welcome tents but require that you or your vendor verify the location of all utility lines *before* you begin setting up. For more information, visit molcall.com or call 1-800-DIG-RITE (344-7483).

Am I required to use preferred caterers or bartenders?

No – the Alexander Majors Barn prides itself on being a flexible venue that keeps our renters' individuality and unique needs in mind. We do not require that you use any specific vendors. However, we can provide recommendations for vendors who are familiar with the Barn upon request.

Can I have candles at my event?

No – open flame, including candles, fireworks, bonfires, or similar is prohibited. The Alexander Majors House is an historic, wooden structure, and we want to preserve the house and grounds for all. Sterno flames are allowed when used for catering/food-service purposes.

What about set up and tear down for my event?

All set up and tear down needs to occur within the 10-hour rental period. If you think that you will need additional time, you may purchase additional hours at a rate of \$80/hour. You may also purchase additional hours for a rehearsal dinner, event set up, or other pre-rental events, dependent on availability.

How much parking is available?

There are 44 spaces available in our graveled/paved lot. This is typically sufficient parking for most occasions. Additional parking is available in the grass behind the lot, dependent on weather.

Can the Alexander Majors House be open to my guests during my event?

If you would like the house to be available for tours during your event, please discuss with your rental coordinator. The House can be opened for tours for an additional fee. A limited number of people are allowed in the House at one time.
