

# HILL-STEAD MUSEUM

## SITE FEES FOR WEDDINGS AND CELEBRATIONS OF ALL KINDS

*for weddings and celebrations booked in 2023*

Recognized as a historic property of exceptional value to the Nation, the 152 acre grounds of the Hill-Stead Museum were designated a National Historic Landmark in 2021; a distinction the 1901 historic house has held since 1991. Surrounded by rolling New England meadows with lawns and gardens bordered by classic dry-stone walls, the property features a sunken garden and offers beautiful settings for celebrations of all kinds.

Events with 100 or more guests take place under a tent on the West Lawn or the Grass Court, the Makeshift Theater is an intimate indoor space for events with under 100 invited guests. Outdoor weddings and large celebrations are a 6 hour rental with a base fee of \$8,500 - \$6,000 for an indoor event with under 100 guests. Additional fees are a \$800 ceremony fee, a \$500 refundable damage deposit, and a \$700 fire watch fee for tented events. An hour-long open house tour of the Museum's first floor can be arranged for \$600. Please inquire about additional ways to make your wedding at Hill-Stead truly historic.
