

The Eclectic Warehouse at 45 Main Street in Eclectic, Alabama

This historic warehouse was built in 1928 and housed a cotton gin that was owned by Aubrey Hornsby's family. Suited for very special events and community engagement, it speaks of charm and grace through its massive timbers, high ceilings, red brick walls and plenty of grassy lawn areas. With 10,000-square-feet, this multi-purpose venue has several event spaces and can make a wedding an affair to remember. It is intimate for 50 guests and can accommodate up to 400. The Sycamore Courtyard is The Warehouse's outdoor lawn area (about an acre shaded in part by a beautiful tree) and is ideal for ceremonies, relaxing moments and cocktail hours. The Warehouse also has an 1800 square-foot lighted outdoor deck. There are also procession areas for sparkler exits and glamourous entrances. For your guests' comfort, the Warehouse has been upgraded with modern cooling and heating systems as well as other improvements without compromising the historical structure. It can also act as an open pavilion with its five 12-foot doors open and can provide rain-date-certainty if your outdoor event needs weather protection. Recent improvements include a 300-year-old church door exiting from the warehouse to the outside deck and custom-built entrance doors onto Main Street using massive timbers and antique design elements.
