Inspired by scholar Dr. Adrian Ebell with the empowering motto, “I will find a way or make one,” The Ebell of Los Angeles was founded in 1894 as a center for bold women to educate and uplift one another. Today, the nonprofit organization is focused on providing a vibrant and inclusive hub for arts, education, culture, and community for its members and all Angelenos.

The Ebell’s philanthropic endeavors include the 104-year-old Ebell/Flint Scholarship that has awarded more than 5,000 scholarships to local college and university students, along with the RCA endowment which awards annual grants totaling more than \$100,000 per year to various nonprofits that assist women and children in need.

Built as a gathering place to connect with renowned artists, educators, authors, entertainers, and politicians. The Ebell is proud to have a storied history hosting diverse, powerful and inspiring women like Amelia Earhart, Sheryl Lee Ralph, and Michelle Obama. LA’s current, and first-ever female mayor, Karen Bass, chose The Ebell as the location for her first speech as Mayor-elect of Los Angeles due to its incredible history in Los Angeles for women.

One of Los Angeles’ Historical Treasures designed by architect Sumner Hunt, and built in 1927, The Ebell’s historic campus commemorates nearly 100 years on LA’s famed Wilshire Boulevard. With three levels and more than 75,000 square feet, the Italian renaissance-inspired structure is a noted architectural treasure listed on the National Register

of Historic Places and a designated Los Angeles Cultural Monument. The campus includes a grand dining room, art salon, courtyard garden, lounge, and 1238-seat Broadway-style theatre.

Given its many rooms and historic ambiance, The Ebell is a favorite location for film and television productions. Countless movies, TV shows, music videos and commercials including “Forrest Gump,” “Wedding Crashers,” “The Addams Family,” and “Babylon” have been filmed here.

The versatility of the surroundings has also made it one of Los Angeles’ favorite event spaces. The campus hosts weddings, B’nai Mitzvahs, holiday parties, conferences, seminars, film premiers, and star-studded award shows including the annual Grammy Nominee Reception, Children & Family Emmy’s, and the MPSE Golden Reel Awards. In addition, The Ebell hosts fundraising events for local non-profits such as Western Center on Law and Poverty and the Girls Academic Leadership Academy.

All proceeds from special events, filming and theatre rentals go directly to support the non-profit organization and its operational costs. This earned income allows The Ebell to remain accessible and inclusive to all and supports the mission. Membership is open to everyone, and we encourage you to join us as we continue to inspire, empower and celebrate together for years to come!

The Dining Room has a built-in air conditioning system while the Lounge and Art Salon do not. We offer an air conditioning rental for the Lounge and Art Salon for \$2,700 and encourage it from July through September.

Here at The Ebell of Los Angeles, we take pride in everything we do especially what comes from our kitchen. We are excited for you and your guests to experience the best California has to offer on your very special occasion. You will be invited to a “Tasting and Details” experience months ahead of your special day. At that event, you will finalize your food, beverage, and design elements with your planner.

All dinner packages are based on 125 person guest count or higher. If your guest count falls below 125 we will require a supplemental personnel charge in order to ensure our excellent and attentive service.
