Built in 1838.....Restored in 2013 over185 years' old.

The Stable was built before:

Before Iowa was a State
Before our territorial capital was Burlington
Before our eighth president (Martin Van Buren) was in office
Before the Civil War (1861-1865)
Before most of western Indian wars
Before the birth of Buffalo Bill Cody
Before the California Gold Rush
Before Thomas Edison invented the light bulb

And built after:

After Davey Crockett fought at the Alamo

After when most rural Americans lived in either Log Cabins or Sod Houses
Built in 1838 using stone taken from a nearby quarry, the Palmer House Stable originally was
used as a mill, but nearby residents complained about the noise it created and the building was
converted to a livery stable.

The Palmer House Stable predates the Palmer House Hotel by 15 years. The nearby hotel was erected in 1855 by Connecticut natives Charles and Cynthia Palmer along Highway 1 where the BP gas station now stands. Acting as a stagecoach stop and hotel with 16 rooms, the Palmer House Hotel allegedly housed some notable characters including Buffalo Bill Cody, according to documents from the lowa State Historical Society.

Keeping up with the times, the stable building was converted in 1917 to house rental automobiles. In 1959, the Palmer House was torn down after standing for 106 years. Solon resident Bob Morris operated a small gas station on the property directly in front of the Stable for 40 years before closing the service station in 1999.

The Palmer House Stable also provides an outdoor setting with fire pit and Adirondack chairs. Roam or unwind with a walk on Solons Main Street and visit the Big Grove Brewery or Bluebird Café.

Fire pit we provide wood and light. Add \$150.

General Information and what we include:

- Main level, tables, and chairs seating 8 per table.
- Refrigerator in the lower level.
- The Stable is air conditioned and heated, rest rooms.
- Open Vendor Policy bring in your own food or cater.
- Tables need to be covered. Tablecloths can be rented white linen for \$16.00 each.
- Clients may provide beer and wine. (For Hard liquor inquire)
- Early access permitted to decorate if the building isn't rented prior to your time.
- 4- 6' Buffet Serving Tables and 1-4' table

- 2-Original rustic barn door tabletops on wheels 2'-8" Wide X 7'-0 Long.
- 3- Large metal farm tubs on stands with wheels for can beer, pop, and water bottles.
- 1-Smaller metal farm tub on a stand with wheels.
- Wireless multi-level Bluetooth sound system. Complimentary Wi Fi.
- All paper products, hand soap, garbage cans, garbage bags. Step ladders, hand tools, and fasteners for decorating and set up.

Prohibited:

No glitter, loose sparkles, fake flower petals.

No tape to be used on the floor or walls please notify your vendors.

No attaching anything to the painted drywall surfaces at all.

No Smoking allowed anywhere on Palmer House Stable Property or on the sidewalk abutting the Stable Property. All Smoking should be across Main Street on the corners.

No kegs allowed, only cans and bottles of beer permitted without permission.

DO NOT invite people not on your guest list onto the property.

If the Hay Loft is used:

Children must always be always accompanied by parents.

The main door must be locked from the time of ceremony until leaving at 8 pm.

Access to the Get Ready room is 9 am and leaving by 8 pm that same day.

No Alcoholic beverages on the city sidewalk.

Violators may be asked to leave, and the event may be shut down at the owner's discretion.

Clients Agree to during Your Event:

- You set up and take down tables and chairs.
- Tables need to be covered.
- Garbage cans should be emptied as they fill up.
- When emptying garbage cans please take the can with the bag inside to the dumpster, do not pull the bag out of the can inside the building! This will ensure that no liquids have leaked on the floor inside the Stable causing a slipping hazard.
- NO tape, staples or nails allowed on the Drywall areas. Nothing leaning against the drywall.
- Cardboard broken down and carried to the dumpster do not put in garbage cans.

At time of Cleanup before leaving:

- Tables folded and rolled to the east wall by the restrooms or where you got them.
- The chairs should lie flat on the carts provided with seats facing up. 50 chairs per cart, 2 carts on the main level by the tables and 2 carts in the lower level by the tables.
- Folding tables should be put outside on the deck by the steel lofts stairway.
- The barn door top tables one downstairs one upstairs.
- If the front terrace is used, please stack the red chairs no more than 6 to a stack by the drooping evergreen tree. All tables and chairs need to be put back.
- A renter utilizing kitchen facilities should follow typical kitchen-cleaning procedures.
- Refrigerator emptied. If the range was used, please clean the surfaces.
- We assure each group using the facility a "Butt Free" property so all cigarette butts
 must be picked up on the property. Please walk the property and dispose of butts properly.
- All items brought into the building including food, containers, decorations, and props.
 must be removed upon the completion of the event and not put in the dumpster.
- The 4 beverage troughs need to be drained and towel dried inside. Please drain the water by the street curb by simply lifting one end to dump. Then put all tubs used in the lower level.
















Hay Loft For Rent

DIRECTIONS:

PALMER HOUSE STABLE is located at 200 East Main St. in Solon Iowa 52333, about 9 miles north of Iowa City/University of Iowa and approximately 19 miles southeast of Cedar Rapids.

FROM Iowa City:

Take Highway 1 North

As you enter Solon turn LEFT on East Main Street.

Look to the right (North) one block from the HWY 1 and East Main intersection.

200 East Main Street

FROM Cedar Rapids:

Take I-380 South

Take exit 10 toward Shueyville East on 120th Street NE.

Stay on 120th Street NE.to Tintersection and stop sign.

Turn right south on Ely Rd.

Turn left onto Route 382/County Rd F16

Continue onto W Main St.

Turn left onto North Dubuque Street Destination will be on the corner of East Main Street and North Dubuque St Solon, IA 52333

FROM Mt Vernon:

Take HWY 1 South.

As you enter Solon turn RIGHT on East Main Street.

Take the 1st Right onto North Dubuque St.


